Searching for housing? Scams are prevalent, so be careful when you rent.



43%

Make sure a listing is legit before you commit.



Never wire transfer a security deposit or first month's rent before meeting the landlord



Always tour or have a person you trust visit the property



Never pay anything before signing a lease
